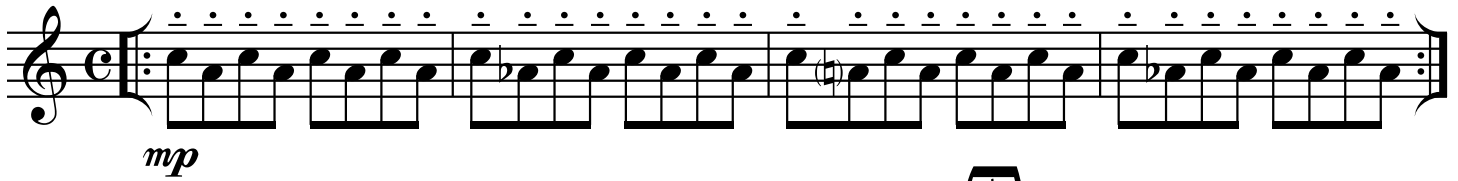
Tenor Sax

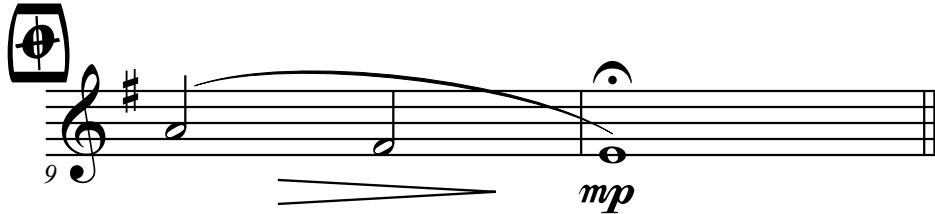
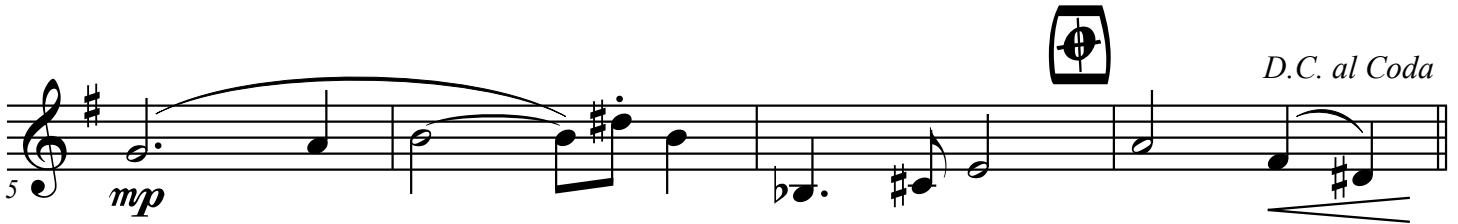
